Our first event was the February 16 **Master Class**. The class was taught by Cherity Koepke of Opera Colorado. Cherity did an outstanding job with the singers, who all really appreciated her insights. As always, the audience found the class extremely entertaining and instructive.

The **Preliminaries** were held on March 16. We had 47 singers registered, but seven singers had to withdraw due to illness. The talent level of all the singers was top notch. Our judges must have had a difficult task in choosing 15 singers to move on to the Finals.

At the March 30 **Finals**, all our singers had the benefit of feedback from our outstanding group of judges. In all, the Guild awarded over \$33,000.00 in prize money to our winners. This was only possible through the generosity of members like you.

Want to give us a try? Call Deanna Leino at 303-424-2641 and let her know you're interested. You'll find us a fun, friendly and welcoming group.


