An opera Master Class - on the surface "entertaining" is not the first word that would come to mind is it? "Informative" perhaps, but "entertaining"? Perhaps not. And yet both are exactly the words I would choose to describe my experience with opera Master Classes. At a Master Class the teacher listens to a singer perform an aria then chooses one or two aspects of the performance to address with the singer. I have seen teachers who emphasize vocal technique, others who stress performance issues. The common denominator has always been a discernable difference in the singer's presentation following their work with the Master Class teacher. For a nonsinger like myself it is always fascinating how much difference a small tweak here or there can make in the whole sound or feel of a phrase or an aria. What is also fascinating is how the teachers can take a valuable learning experience for the singer and make it informative - yes, but also fun and entertaining for both the singer and the audience. It's amazing how quickly the time flies when you can learn, laugh and hear beautiful music at the same time!

This year's DLOG Master Class looks to be a great example of "fun and informative". It will be held from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Saturday, February 6, 2016. Like other Competition

related events it will be held at Bethany Lutheran Church. Heading our Master Class will be Dr. Robert Harrison. Dr. Harrison taught voice for 23 years at the University of Colorado at Boulder, serving as the chair of the Voice Department for ten years. Following his tenure at CU, he accepted a position as Professor of Voice at the prestigious Jacobs School of Music at Indiana University from which he recently retired. He has held master classes around the world and has performed at the White House. His students have won many major awards including the Met National Council, Denver Lyric Opera Guild, and have performed at major opera houses across the United States and on PBS Great Performances. Dr. Harrison specializes in the Bel Canto style. I am told he is a wonderful teacher and "quite a character". Truly the best of both worlds. Come join us for a day of learning and fun!
