University of Denver Lamont School of Music Convocation

It was a pleasure to represent DLOG at the Denver University Lamont School of Music Convocation on June 4, 2021, via Zoom, with over 300 participating. The program began with the orchestra playing Aaron Copland's "Fanfare to the Common Man." Keith Ward, school director, read the name of every single graduate and encouraged cheering after each name. Robert Wolff received the distinguished alumni award. There were special awards outside the university (winners of competitions), university honors, Lamont school awards, monetary awards (including DLOG), and closing remarks. The convocation ended with music: an original jazz composition called "Sleek" by student Quinn Dymalski.

Prior to presenting the DLOG award, I gave short talk about the mission of DLOG, our grants, our up-coming competition, and our website. Then with the assistance of Sara Bardill, head of the voice department, we presented the \$4000.00 award given by DLOG to DU to three very deserving voice students (they each received \$1333.33). They are Justin Given, baritone, performer's graduate certificate (he also completed his undergrad at DU) from Parker, CO; Kimberly Gnagey, soprano, MM graduate from Plymouth, MI; Julianne Perkins, soprano, MM graduate from Milwaukee, WI.

The entire convocation was well done and far from dull. It was very exciting with constant cheering--displaying the closeness and camaraderie among the students and faculty.

After the meeting ended, I received several emails from the director and members of the faculty thanking DLOG for participating and for giving the grant to the school. We are very much appreciated by the school staff and all the students.


